My thesis in 100 words: Yuet-Man Li

My thesis is about school STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) and SEN education (education for students with special educational needs) innovations in the public schools. I compiled a dataset about what Hong Kong public schools have done on STEM and SEN education in the previous two years. The data shows some interesting patterns that partially confirm the linkage between school status and school innovation, a prediction drawn from Erza Zuckerman's

theory. With participant observations in 15 schools and in-depth interviews with 60 education participants, I also proposed some mechanism-based hypotheses to the causal relations between organizational status and its innovative capacity.
